



## Application for 2026 Waunakee High School Senior Scholarship

*(Two - \$2000 scholarships are awarded)*

### Eligibility Guidelines

1. The selected students must be a graduating senior, completing high school in the current academic year at Waunakee Community High School.
2. The selected students must have a parent or guardian that is a Waunakee Area Chamber of Commerce member in good standing with the Waunakee Area Chamber of Commerce, or the student must be employed at a Chamber Member Business.
3. The selected students must be registered as a full-time student (12 credits minimum) at an accredited college or technical school in the fall of 2026.
4. The selected students must volunteer for eight (8) hours at any combination of the following Chamber-related activities.
  - WaunaBoom set up (7/3/26), tear down (7/4/26)
  - WaunaFest Run set up (7/21/26–7/24/26)
  - WaunaFest Run (morning of 7/25/26)
  - WaunaFest festival grounds at Centennial Park set up (7/23/26) and tear down (7/27/26)
5. The selected students will be recognized for the scholarship at the WHS Senior Awards Night on May 13th, 2026. The scholarship will be disbursed when the volunteer hours are satisfied.

### How to Apply

1. Complete the attached application. An online application form is available at [www.waunakeechamber.com](http://www.waunakeechamber.com) under the Community tab, Waunakee Community School District.
2. Include **TWO** letters of recommendation: \*One from a **teacher or administrator** and \*One from a **work or volunteer/community service supervisor**.
3. **Mail or drop off your completed application and letters of recommendation at the Waunakee Area Chamber of Commerce office no later than 4:00 PM on Friday, May 1, 2026. All materials must be received by this deadline.**
